SUBJECT: Updated Family Income Guidelines for South Carolina

ISSUANCE DATE: May 8, 2003

EFFECTIVE DATE: Immediately

EXPIRATION DATE: Indefinite

Attached are the Family Income Guidelines for South Carolina effective March 3, 2003. The guidelines incorporate the latest 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The figure for a particular family size is the maximum household income the individual is permitted in order to qualify as low income under WIA. This issuance supersedes all previously issued Family Guidelines.

The revised Poverty Income Guidelines for South Carolina are also attached. The Poverty Guidelines are used to determine eligibility for dislocated workers who are in need of financial assistance (needs-related payments) to participant in the training programs under WIA.

These guidelines are to be used in determining eligibility for youth and adults. For adults, 150% of the Lower Living Standard Income Levels is considered to be the self-sufficiency level.
