Attached are updated WIA Family Income Guidelines for South Carolina. The guidelines incorporate the latest 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) from the U. S. Department of Labor and the Poverty Guidelines from the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services. The figure for a particular family size is the maximum household income the individual is permitted in order to qualify as low income under WIA.

The revised Poverty Income Guidelines for South Carolina are also attached. The Poverty Guidelines are used to determine eligibility for dislocated workers who are in need of financial assistance (Needs-related Payments) to participate in training programs under WIA.
