Attached are the updated Family Income Guidelines for South Carolina effective immediately. The guidelines incorporate the latest 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The figure for a particular family size is the maximum household income the individual is permitted in order to qualify as low income under WIA. This issuance supersedes all previously issued Family Guidelines.

The 2005 100% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) is also attached. The 100% LLSIL guidelines are used to determine the minimum level for establishing criteria to set self-sufficiency for employed adults and dislocated workers.

Please replace pages 9 (WIA Family Income Guidelines), 10 (WIA Self-Sufficiency Guidelines), and 11 (Poverty Income Guidelines) of the SC Virtual One-Stop Procedures Manual. Make additional copies and distribute within your agency as necessary.
